Back in KOREA!!! It all happened so quick... last letter we mentioned a contact at the Korean Consulate that made things happen. After a couple weeks all the paperwork was finalized, and we immediately made plans to return to Korea. Bought tickets one week and left the next.

We unfortunately returned to two roof leaks due to an 80 year high in rain fall and bad weather. Much time and resource will be needed to repair the damage and also discard the ruined personal items. The Lord knows and it's no one's fault. It is what can happen with a transient lifestyle.

We are however grateful to reacquaint with several people of our last ministry. They have transitioned well for which we are grateful. I'd like to think that we are indispensable, but it is the Lord that builds His church...we are called to just be faithful.

More opportunity has already been seen. We will however endeavor to remain patient and take the needed time to settle back in. We are looking forward to some specific opportunities in the near future.

We praise the Lord... tickets were \$3050 per person when we last checked to buy.
